Public Guardian Investigation

- Referral Screening
- Initial investigation steps
- Face-to-face meeting with client
- Interviewing medical staff and/or caregiving services
- Locating family
- Exploring viable alternatives






Record review

- Real Property Information
- Bank Accounts
- Investment Accounts
- Estate Plan
 - Living Trusts
 - Last Will and Testament
- Tax records




Public Guardian's Decision

- Public Guardian decides to act
- Certificate of Authority
- Obtaining nomination and/or declinations
- Request completion of capacity declaration by physician
- Completing petition
- Temporary Letters of Conservatorship



Certificate of Authority CA PC 2901 / 2901.5


- Freeze bank account
- Cancel ATM card
- Freeze investment account
- Obtain detailed financial information from all institutions



What happened to Nancy

- Temporary powers-kept in her home
- Continued with caregiving services
- Paid her bills for food, clothing and shelter
- Advanced money to pay for condo and insurance






Law Enforcement Actions

- Arrested prior caregiver, husband and daughter
- Seized car, Britney Spears concert tickets, baby crib, jewelry, furnishings, collectibles, computer, musical instruments and parrot
- Found a variety of promissory notes



Case Administration

- Marshaled assets
- Redirected income
- Cash flow issues
- Filed claim against Home Health Care Agency
- Appointed successor trustee on trust
- Obtained court authorization to dissolve charitable trust
- Authorization to sell principal residence
- Demanded accounting from prior trustee
- Moved Nancy to Board and Care facility
- Negotiated debts
- IRS problem Still pending to date




What happens to the thieves

- Caregiver pleaded guilty to 3 felony counts
- Sentenced to 13 years in state prison
- Ordered to pay restitution \$642,000 and fined \$1,285,000
- Husband convicted on 1 felony count and sentenced to 1 year in county jail and 3 years probation
- Daughter convicted on 1 felony count and sentenced to 93 days in county jail and 3 years formal probation

Where we are today

- Sheriff will sell everything and provide proceeds to Nancy
- What to do with the parrot
- Trust issue still outstanding
- Nancy passed away 4/2012
- Tax issues unresolved





Elder Abuse Trends

- Elder Abuse is under-reported
- Neglect is most often reported
- Number of referrals does not indicate severity of abuse
 - 2011 272 referrals
 - 2012 202 referrals
 - 2013 115 referrals (to date)
- Most difficult referrals are financial abuse committed by adult children
- PG Recovered Assets:

- 2010 approximately \$12,400,000
- 2011 approximately \$ 3,602,000
- 2012 approximately \$ 4,000,000
