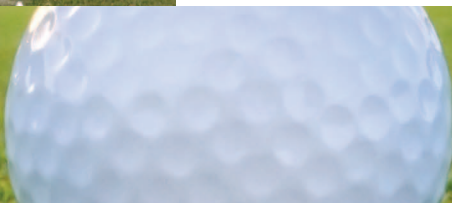

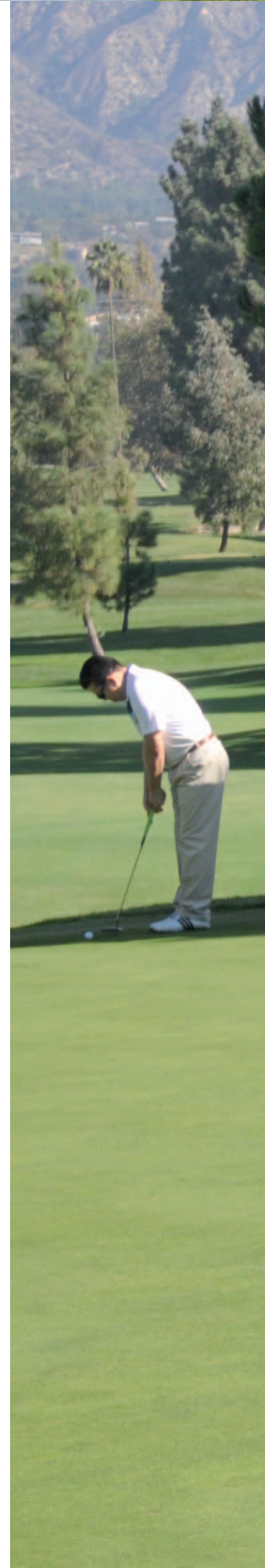

NHF DELIVERS

With programs addressing community health, patient safety, and length of hospital stay, NHF continues to make resounding contributions in quality improvements and cost savings within the health care continuum. In 2013, NHF's Recuperative Care Program saved Southern California hospitals more than \$4 million through cost prevention. Hospitals participating in Patient Safety First – a flagship program focusing on improving patient safety – have reduced early elective deliveries, as well as cases of sepsis mortality, ventilator associated pneumonia, and central line blood stream infections. This work has resulted in over \$63 million dollars in cost savings over three years.
