Operating Room Nurses provide professional nursing care to patients undergoing surgery by preparing and maintaining the operating room for all surgical procedures including special equipment needed for daily procedures and emergencies, positioning the patient, assisting, scrubbing, and circulating. This 16-week course will provide basic didactic perioperative education that will give the novice OR nurse the rationale and theory needed to provide safe patient care, used in conjunction with a clinical preceptorship.

Course Cost (\$2,280) includes:

- Preceptored clinical experience
