Course Description

Critical thinking is central to effective task management and decision making in high-risk situations. This class reviews how active assessment and analysis of information can help evaluate and improve the quality of thinking, and discusses the key principles and barriers to thinking critically. The course also covers the application of critical thinking through the nursing process to help staff arrive at the appropriate decision or conclusion.

Course Objectives

- Be able to define critical thinking.
- 2. Gain knowledge and insight into analyzing, reasoning and evaluating problems.
- 3. Become knowledgeable about intellectual standards.
- 4. Recognize the barriers about the application of critical thinking in nursing practice.

- 6. Be able to discuss the feeling, vision and examination models.
