The Wound Care Education Institute is a dedicated center of education designed to provide students with a comprehensive training program for the management of wounds and skin care. Our training program was developed on the principles of evidence based research utilizing the AHRQ Clinical Practice guidelines, current practice trends and standards.

CERTIFICATION

Upon completion of The Wound Management Course, all qualified participants are eligible to take the Wound Care Certification Exam at the end of the seminar. The Wound Care Certification Exam is offered by the National Alliance of Wound Care, NAWC®. The initials WCC® are the certification mark of the National Alliance of Wound Care. When you become certified you may use the credentials WCC®. Wound Care Certified, Certification provides an added credential beyond licensure and demonstrates by examination that you have acquired a core body of specialized knowledge.

Anyone can attend the course. Those wishing to take the NAWC® WCC® National Certification Exam must meet the following criteria:

Active U.S. unrestricted license in one of the following professions:

- IPN/IVN
- RN/NP
- OT / PT / PTA • MD / DO / DPM / PA
- While actively licensed, candidate must show at least two years' full-time

or four years' part-time wound care experience within the past five years. Candidate may participate in the NAWC[®] Preceptor Program in lieu of required experience.
