California Division of Occupational Safety & Health (Cal/OSHA) standards went into effect April 1. The new regulations require health facilities, home health and hospice providers and emergency responders to develop workplace violence prevention plans, assess the workplace, correct identified hazards, train employees and keep records related to workplace violence incidents. The regulations also require hospitals to report specified incidents to Cal/OSHA. Organizations must meet the training requirements by the April 1, 2018 compliance date.
